BOYNTON BEACH SCUBA daytrip

Saturday April 19, 2025

Join us again for a Boynton Beach Daytrip. 2 dives, one on the MV Castor shipwreck, second one a reef drift. This trip is Advanced Openwater level required. The MV Castor was a 258' foot long, 37' wide Dutch Freighter. The Castor was sunk in 2001. She sits in 110' feet of water, with the deck in 95-100' and the bow in about 80'. We follow that dive up with one of Boynton's beautiful reef drift dives. Space is limited, these sell out, sign up asap! Air tanks are included but you must pickup and return to our Ft. Myers store, first come first serve, or we can fill your own tanks. Nitrox is \$12 additional and can not be reserved, we may run out. You must bring/haul any gear that you need, rental fees apply. This will be great fun, good for photography or spearfishing with license, or just enjoying the dives! You must be in Boynton at 12:45 p.m. for a 1:30 departure.
